## GENERAL INFORMATION FOR SC616

**Purpose of SC616** - By filing SC616, the taxpayer notifies the SC Department of Revenue of the county in which the new facility or expansion is planned, the number of new jobs expected to be created and when the new facility or expansion is planned. The Department will then "lock in" the county designation for the year or years indicated.

**When to File** - SC616 must be filed **before** the initial staffing of the new facility or expansion begins.

**Period Valid** - SC616 is valid for all new jobs created during the original 5 year job tax credit period.
